## **Minority-Owned Business Gets State Support to Grow**

*Cincinnati-based company receives bond increase to grow*

A Cincinnati-based company received help from the state today to take their businesses to the next level. The Ohio Development Services Agency provided a \$1 million bond request to Showcase Building & Design, Inc. A bond is an insurance policy for a project owner that guarantees that work will be completed by a general contractor or sub-contractor.

"Continued growth is a key element for any successful business," said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency. "The Minority Development Finance Advisory Board provides minority-owned business the tools they need for expansion and job creation."

**Showcase Building & Design, Inc.** will receive a bonding line increase from \$500,000 to \$1 million in order to bid on a wider variety of government and public projects. Showcase Building and Design, a state-certified Minority Business Enterprise, is a building design and construction company in Cincinnati. The company specializes in custom homes, luxury homes, remodeling additions, youth centers, churches, medical clinics, daycare centers, laundromats and retail centers.

All projects approved by this board must go to Controlling Board for approval.
