State Supporting Entrepreneurship

Ohio is encouraging entrepreneurs to bring their ideas and business here, with Ohio Third Frontier gearing up for another round of funding to support technology innovation.

Ohio's New Entrepreneurs Fund (ONE Fund) is accepting proposals from business accelerators in Ohio that will provide funding to teams of entrepreneurs in 2014. The accelerators recruit talent from Ohio and across the country, guiding them through a business "boot camp" and connecting them with potential investors to launch their companies.

"Ohio supports entrepreneurs, knowing these are the companies of tomorrow," said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency and chair of the Ohio Third Frontier Commission. "We want them to know Ohio is the place to bring and grow your high-tech company."

The ONE Fund started in 2011 and has helped launch several technology businesses. SnapBatch, a mobile gaming platform, allows sports fans to play games on their smartphones or tablets using live data from the event. Sprav is working on a smart meter for showers that will help people conserve water and lower their bills.
