State Helps Improve Sanitary Sewer System in Wood County

Wood County will receive a grant to improve the sanitary sewer system for Liberty Township residents in the Northwestern Water and Sewer District. The grant is through the Residential Public Infrastructure Program and funded by the Community Development Block Grant.

The county will receive a \$398,900 grant to install approximately 8,000 linear feet of sewer line and 37 grinder pumps. The county will also help connect 13 low- and moderate-income households to the new line. The improvements will benefit 33 households in the area.

“Reliable and safe water systems are integral to providing Ohioans with a strong quality of life,” said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency.

The Residential Public Infrastructure Program is administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency’s Office of Community Development.
