Grant to Improve Water System in Village of Lewisburg

COLUMBUS – The village of Lewisburg (Preble County) will receive a grant to improve the village water system. The grant is from the Community Development Block Grant, Residential Public Infrastructure Program.

The village will receive a \$400,000 grant to make upgrades to the village wastewater treatment plant. The grant is supported by \$1.3 million of other funding sources that will go toward the project costs. The upgraded plant will benefit 643 households in the area.

“We want to ensure that the village has an efficient and safe water system,” said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency. “Reliable infrastructure improves the quality of life for the people in the village and makes it more attractive to job creators.”

The Community Development Block Grant Program is administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency’s Office of Community Development.
