Grant to Improve Water System in the Village of Ada

COLUMBUS – The village of Ada (Hardin County) will receive a grant to improve the village water system. The grant is from the Community Development Block Grant, Residential Public Infrastructure Program.

The village will receive a \$500,000 grant to expand the wastewater treatment plant and will generate more than \$9 million of other public funding sources. The upgraded plant will benefit 1,608 households in the area.

“Reliable infrastructure improves the quality of life for the people in the village and makes it more attractive to job creators,” said David Goodman, director of the Ohio Development Services Agency.

The Community Development Block Grant Program is administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency’s Office of Community Development.
